

## My Alpha-1 Checklist for Lung Disease

If you have been diagnosed with lung disease due to Alpha-1 Antitrypsin Deficiency (AATD), it may be helpful to discuss the topics below with your AlphaNet Coordinator and your healthcare provider. 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<ul> <li>✓ The following testing is recommended:</li> <li>□ Pulmonary function testing annually</li> <li>□ Chest x-ray or chest CT (baseline and as indicated)</li> <li>□ Bone densitometry (baseline and as indicated)</li> <li>□ Liver ultrasound after age 50 and as indicated</li> <li>□ Liver blood panel annually</li> </ul>			
<ul> <li>✓ Keep a complete written list of all your medications.</li> <li>✓ Some individuals with lung disease due to AATD are prescribed augmentation therapy. If you are prescribed augmentation therapy you should note the brand name</li></ul>			
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
